



polytec do not recommend the use of Decorative 16mm products in a sliding or non-fixed application (hinged) unless the use of a mechanical stabilising system is fitted. Decorative 16mm doors & panels are supplied with a protective film to protect the surface during installation. This film must be removed within three months of installation.

Your Decorative 16mm doors & panels are made from a Moisture Resistant Medium Density Fibreboard (MR MDF), but as with many wood based panels, they are not waterproof. Care should be taken to wipe up spills immediately, ensuring the doors are not exposed to high or continuous levels of moisture, steam and humidity.

Decorative 16mm doors & panels should be cleaned by wiping down with a damp soft cloth and warm soapy water. Followed by drying using a soft or microfibre cloth so as not to leave any residue on the door or panel. For more stubborn stains use a good quality streak free glass cleaner. Always ensure you refer to the recommendations provided by the manufacturer of the cleaning product before use.
